**MONETARY DETERMINATION OF
EMERGENCY UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION**

Weekly Benefit Amount: \$
Your weekly benefit amount (WBA) is based upon the WBA of your original claim for regular unemployment insurance (UI) benefits.
Maximum Payable: \$
Your maximum payable is equal to the lesser amount of the following calculations: 13 times your WBA or 50 percent of the maximum benefit amount on your original claim for regular UI benefits. The maximum payable is based upon federal guidelines for Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC).
Benefit-Year-End Date:
Your benefit-year-end (BYE) date is the same as that on your original UI claim. You can receive EUC benefits beyond the BYE date if it is determined that you are not eligible for regular UI benefits on a new UI claim.

The last payable week of EUC is 07/04/2009. Even if the BYE date on your claim is later than 07/04/2009, EUC benefits **cannot** be paid beyond this date. This is based upon current federal guidelines for EUC.

EUC is subject to state and federal income taxes.

This monetary determination is based upon your regular claim for UI benefits. If you disagree with this determination, you may request a correction to your original monetary determination by submitting proof of wages.
